

Corona Connecting

Coach's Corner

If you are like me, you can't wait to get out and Tee it up again. By this time, we should have already played a few rounds and brushed off the cobwebs. So, for those who haven't done that yet, here are some tips.

1. Grips - the first thing you need to do is check your grips and make sure they are not worn out. Did you know you should actually change your grips every year? If that is not in the budget, especially if you may not have been working, try scrubbing the grips down with a mild detergent. That should help.
2. Grooves - The grooves on the face of your club need to be free of all debris. Take a brush, a tee or even a toothpick and clean out the grooves. There are studies that when your grooves are clean, especially wedges, your golf ball will stay on the green better.
3. Spike Check - Soft spikes will only last twenty to thirty rounds before they need to be replaced. If the rubber spikes have been worn down to nubs, it's time to make a change. Some golf courses will change your spikes for you, however for under \$30 you can get a wrench and 18 spikes and do it yourself.
4. Bag Check - Do an inventory of your bag and make sure you have tees, balls, ball markers, permanent marker, gloves and sunscreen. Never forget the sunscreen! Hopefully you won't find any unwanted items left over from last year.
5. Mark your Golf Balls - Use your permanent marker and make sure to mark your golf balls. So many golfers play with other golfers who use the same golf balls. If you mark the golf ball now, you won't be doing it on the tee.
6. Play in RevelationGolf's Fundraiser on August 24, 2020!
